No.	Grammar structures	Example
1	Present Simple Tense	- I go to school every day. - He doesn't play football today.
2	Present Continuous Tense	- She's doing homework. - Are you eating dinner?
3	Present Perfect Tense	- We have arrived at the airport. - It has been cold lately.
4	Past Simple Tense	- They weren't home yesterday. - Did you meet him last week?
5	Past Continuous Tense	- We were going shopping this time last week. - I was cooking at 4:00PM yesterday.
6	Future Simple Tense	- I will be there tomorrow. - She won't go to the cinema.
7	Near Future Tense with <i>be going to</i>	We're going to visit our grandparents next week.
8	Modal verbs: – May – Might – Should – Will	- Emma may go to the library after school. - It might rain tomorrow. - You should eat more vegetables. - David will visit his grandparents this weekend.
9	Comparatives and Superlatives	- He's taller than me. (<i>comparative</i>) - He's the tallest in my class. (<i>superlative</i>)
10	Determiners	I have a few apples left in my bag.
11	Prepositions	We stayed at the beach until the sun went down.
12	Pronouns	Does anyone know the answer to this question?
13	Tag questions	You just bought the newspaper, didn't you?
14	Adverbs	The little boy runs very fast in the park.

15	Conjunction	She was tired, so she went to bed early.
16	Zero Conditional Sentences	If you don't sleep well, you feel tired.
17	Clause with "Where" <i>(S1 + V1 + O1 (a place) + where + S2 + V2 + O2)</i>	I know a restaurant where they serve the best pizza in town.
18	Clause with "Before" / "After"	- Tell me before you go. - She can watch the cartoon after she finishes her homework.
19	Linking verbs + like <i>(Linking verbs: be, feel, smell, sound, taste, look)</i>	The biscuits taste delicious.
20	make + O + adjective	This makes the adventure exciting.
