Suitability for English teaching content <i>Does the platform support various content types like videos, interactive exercises, language games, and automatic assessments?</i>	
Mobile adaptability and flexible access <i>Is the platform responsive and accessible on phones, tablets, and desktops for learning anytime, anywhere?</i>	
Learning progress analytics and reporting <i>Does the platform offer tools for tracking student progress, engagement, and learning outcomes?</i>	
Integration with existing systems <i>Can the platform integrate with Learning Management Systems (LMS), Human Resource Management Systems (HRMS), and other content creation tools?</i>	
Reasonable and transparent pricing <i>Does the platform have transparent pricing that makes it easy to evaluate costs such as licensing, customization, and technical support?</i>	
Scalability and flexibility <i>Is the platform scalable to accommodate increasing numbers of students, courses, and features?</i>	
Gamification and interactive learning features <i>Does the platform include game-like elements such as points, badges, and leaderboards to motivate students?</i>	
Customization and multilingual support <i>Can the platform be customized to meet specific teaching needs and support multiple languages?</i>
