

#### **LESSON PLAN 1**

(The focus: Past Simple Tense Main approach used: Deductive Approach)

## 1. Description of the Class

• Level: A2

• Students: Grade 6

• Class size: 23-25 students

## 2. Aims and Objectives

By the end of the lesson, students will be able to:

- Understand the form of the past simple tense (regular & irregular verbs).
- Use the past simple tense to talk about completed actions in the past.
- Improve speaking and writing fluency through short tasks.

#### 4. Procedure

Stage	Time	Teacher's Role	Students' Role
Warm-up & Lead-in	5'	<ul> <li>Show 2-3 pictures of activities (e.g., playing football, eating ice cream).</li> <li>Ask: "What did you do yesterday?"</li> </ul>	Respond with simple sentences (may use L1 if needed).
Presentation	10'	<ul> <li>Present rules of past simple.</li> <li>Write examples on the board.</li> <li>Explain positive/ negative/ question forms.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Take notes.</li> <li>Repeat examples.</li> <li>Answer quick concept-check questions.</li> </ul>
Controlled Practice	10'	<ul><li>Provide gap-fill worksheet.</li><li>Monitor and support.</li></ul>	<ul> <li>Complete sentences individually.</li> <li>Check answers in pairs.</li> </ul>
Semi-controlled Practice	10'	<ul> <li>Ask students Yes/ No and Wh- questions about their past weekend.</li> </ul>	Ask and answer using past simple.
Production	7'	Organize a short	Walk around, ask

		"Find someone who" activity (e.g., Find someone who watched TV yesterday).	classmates questions, record answers.
Wrap-up	3'	<ul> <li>Review form of past simple.</li> <li>Assign homework: Write 5 sentences about yesterday.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Listen, ask final questions, note down homework.</li> </ul>
